- [What to do if your child has symptoms](#): Please stay home. Contact your physician and call the KZV office.
- [What to do if my child has an exposure](#): Stay home, notify the school if the exposure was through the community, and get tested if possible.
- [What to do if a family member tests positive](#): Stay home, notify the school, and quarantine for 14 days after last exposure.
- [What to expect if a student has an exposure](#): The student will stay home and be asked to quarantine for 14 days, the administration will notify the affected class(es), the cohort will remain open.
- [What to expect if there is a confirmed case in class](#): Student will stay home for at least 10 days after first symptoms, cohort closed for 14 days after last exposure. Cohorts that are not exposed will stay open.

When in doubt, please stay home and contact the school office. SFDPH can help assess a specific situation to assure we are doing our best to keep students and faculty safe.
